Aged in Oak Barrels for eighteen months. The other of two Grand Crus grown by Alain Moueix with biodynamic / organic cultivating methods.

As indicated by the name, this chateau is located on the chalky rock that makes the bed of the village of Saint Emilion itself. The estate, property of his family since 1930, is now managed by Alain Moueix with the same organic methods applied in Moulin du Cadet.

Tasting Notes: The robe is intense with highlights. A very oaky and toasty nose, hinting at prune, brandy, spices and a touch of musk. The generous palate has a very
