

Château Clos Junet SAINT-EMILION GRAND CRU



Area: 1.6 Hectares **Production:** 650 cases

Wine-making: Traditional and modern. Manual harvesting.

Location: Commune of Saint-Emilion AOC Grand Cru, the property is located at the tip of "Château L'Angelus."

Soil: Deep, ancient sands over a vein of red clay/limestone.

Blend: 65% Merlot, 25% Cab Franc, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon

History: This family property was bought in the 19th C. by the present owner's great-grandfather. The vineyard of Clos Junet lies on gentle, sandy-glacis slopes to the west of the Saint-Emilion limestone plateau. Patrick Junet explains that the nature of the terroir plus the blend of its three traditional grape varieties give the wines of Clos Junet the softness and roundness and other qualities which enable Clos Junet to be regularly awarded with the controlled appellation:

Tasting Notes: This remarkable 2003 has a superb Bordeaux Robe. The nose announces a great moment to come; scents of flowers and fruits (cherries) and licorice. Soft, round and mellow to the palate, it nevertheless has the great Terroir undertone which classifies it as a Grand Vin.
