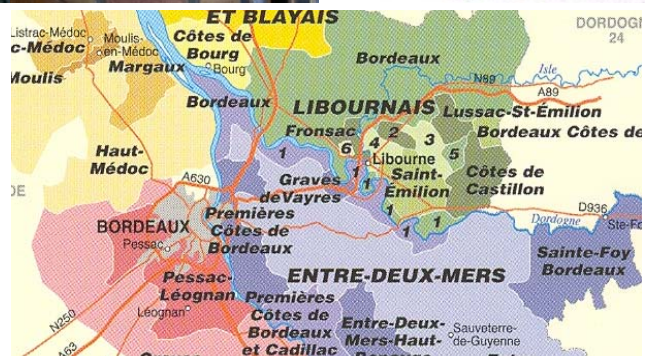


Château Fongaban Côtes de Castillon
